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Rules: QRP ARCI All Continents Award

1. The QRP ARCI All Continents Award is available to all amateurs worldwide who confirm they have contacted each of the six continents while running QRP.
2. The continents are - North America, South America, Oceania, Europe, Asia and Africa.
3. Australia is a country, part of Oceania, not a continent.
4. Antarctica is part of Oceania.
5. A list of stations worked and a QRP ARCI GCR form are required.
6. Band and Mode endorsements are available..
7. Contacts must be made from the same location, or from locations no two of which are more than 50 miles apart which is affirmed by signature of the applicant on the application. Club station applicants, please include clearly the club name and call sign of the club station (or trustee).
8. Contacts may be made over any period of years. Contacts must be confirmed by submitting the QRP ARCI GCR Form and a QRP ARCI All Continent Form.
9. Applications for endorsements must submit confirmations that clearly confirm two way contact on the specialty mode/band on the continent form and also submit a QRP ARCI GCR Form..
10. Endorsements are available for SSTV, 432 MHz, 222 MHz, 144 MHz, 50 MHz, CW and SSB.
11. QRP operation for QRP ARCI purposes is defined as operation with a transmitter power output equal to or less than 10 W PEP output for single-sideband or double-sideband phone (suppressed or full-carrier) and equal to or less than 5 W PEP output for other modes (e.g. CW, FM, AM, digital). This is affirmed by the signature of the applicant on the application.
12. Contacts made through "repeater" devices or any other power relay method cannot be used for QRP ARCI Worked All Continents confirmation.
13. The QRP ARCI also sponsors a 5-Band All Continents Award, 7-Band All Continents Award and an 8-Band All Continents Award. Each award requires a separate submission.
