Rules: QRP ARCI All States Award

1. The QRP All States Award is available to all amateurs worldwide who confirm they have contacted each of the 50 states of the United States of America. The QRP ARCI All States Awards Program includes the Basic Mixed Award, Satellite Award and the Digital Award. In addition, endorsement certificates are available as listed below. The digital and Satellite awards are dated and numbered as of March 1, 2015. The digital award is either mixed or by mode.

2. Two way communications must be established on amateur bands with each state. Endorsements must be two way on that band and/or mode. There is no minimum signal report required. Any or all bands may be used for general QRP ARCI All States Award. The District of Columbia may be counted for Maryland.

3. Contacts must be made from the same location, or from locations no two of which are more than 50 miles apart which is affirmed by signature of the applicant on the application. Club station applicants, please include clearly the club name and call sign of the club station (or trustee).

4. Contacts may be made over any period of years. Contacts must be confirmed by submitting the QRP ARCI All States Record Sheet.

Applications for endorsements must submit confirmations that clearly confirm two way contact on the specialty mode/band on the Record Sheet. Contacts made with Alaska must be dated January 3, 1959 or later and with Hawaii dated August 21, 1959, or after.

5. Endorsements are available for SSTV, 432 MHz, 222 MHz, 144 MHz, 50 MHz, CW and SSB, PM, Portable and Natural Power. (Wind, Sun etc.)

6. QRP operation for QRP ARCI purposes is defined as operation with a transmitter power output equal to or less than 10 W PEP output for single-sideband or double-sideband phone (suppressed or full-carrier) and equal to or less than 5 W PEP output for other modes (e.g. CW, FM, AM, digital). This is affirmed by the signature of the applicant on the application.

7. Contacts made through "repeater" devices or any other power relay method cannot be used for QRP ARCI Worked All US States confirmation. A separate QRP All States Award is available for Satellite contacts. All stations contacted must be "land stations." Contact with ships, anchored or otherwise, and aircraft, cannot be counted.
